Salzburg to Mondsee and Lake District

Day 8: Saturday, September 6, 2025

Salzburg to Innsbruck

After breakfast, we depart Salzburg and journey to Innsbruck, a charming city set in the heart of the Austrian Alps (approximately a 2-hour drive). Upon arrival, we'll begin our exploration of Innsbruck's historic highlights. Our first stop is the Golden Roof, a landmark adorned with over 2,500 gilded tiles, where we'll learn about the city's medieval and imperial past. Next, we'll visit the Hofburg Palace, a former imperial residence that showcases stunning architecture and offers a glimpse into Austria's royal heritage, all set against a backdrop of breathtaking alpine views. Evening at Leisure: The evening is yours to enjoy Innsbruck's enchanting Old Town with its quaint streets and boutique shops, or to relax at your hotel, soaking in the tranquility of the mountains surrounding this picturesque city. **Meals: Breakfast**
