

Depart USA - Rome



Rome, Italy

Rome Temple - Ancient Rome

Begin your morning at the inspiring Rome Italy Temple (optional), where sacred beauty and modern design converge in a peaceful sanctuary. After a break for lunch (on own), dive into the storied past of Ancient Rome. Gaze across the rooftops from Capitoline Hill, walk the Via Sacra through the Roman Forum. Step inside the Colosseum and hear echoes of gladiators beneath the Roman sun. Overnight in Rome.

Day 4: Wednesday, April 15, 2026

Florence Day Trip by High-Speed Train

Depart Rome by High-Speed train to Florence, the Cradle of Renaissance! Uncover the genius of the Renaissance with a morning guided walking tour. Marvel at the Florence Cathedral and its iconic dome, cross the Ponte Vecchio and visit Piazza della Signoria, see Michelangelo's David at the Accademia Gallery —an unforgettable encounter. Spend the balance of the day exploring on your own: shop for leather, visit the Mercato Centrale or relax in a garden. Return to Rome in the evening. Overnight in Rome. **Meals: Breakfast**

Day 5: Thursday, April 16, 2026

Vatican Museum, Sistine Chapel & St. Peter's Basilica - Afternoon at leisure

Today, faith and art converge at the Vatican. Walk through the Vatican Museums, home to centuries of masterpieces, marvel









at the ceiling of the Sistine Chapel - Michelangelo's divine vision in radiant fresco, enter the breathtaking St. Peter's Basilica, where devotion echoes under its majestic dome. After some free time for lunch and shopping, the afternoon is yours—relax at an outdoor café, wander cobbled alleys, or enjoy gelato in a sundrenched piazza. Overnight in Rome. **Meals: Breakfast,**

Day 6: Friday, April 17, 2026

Pompeii - Sorrento

Depart Rome and journey south toward Campania. Explore the haunting ruins of Pompeii, the only archaeological site which gives the real image of a Roman city, with well-preserved buildings buried under meters of ash and lava after the Vesuvius eruption in 79 AD. At the time of the eruption, experts estimate the town had about 35,000 inhabitants. Today, this UNESCO World Heritage Site is one of the most popular tourist attractions of Italy. Free time for lunch. Afternoon, arrive in Sorrento, a coastal gem perched above the sea, where lemon-scented breezes and Mediterranean charm await. Overnight in Sorrento. **Meals: Breakfast**

Day 7: Saturday, April 18, 2026

Amalfi Coast boat tour - Amalfi & Positano

Embark on a breathtaking journey along the Amalfi Coast—a UNESCO-listed ribbon of cliffs, colors, and culture. Drive along the scenic coastal from Sorrento to Amalfi. Explore Amalfi, with its striking cathedral and historic streets. Free time for lunch. Wander through Positano, where pastel buildings tumble toward the sea. Sail across turquoise waters past dramatic coastal scenery back to Sorrento. Enjoy your second dreamy night by the bay. Overnight in Sorrento. **Meals: Breakfast**

Day 8: Sunday, April 19, 2026

Capri Island

Depart for a full-day excursion to the island of Capri. The craggy, flower-covered island is home to artistic, historical and natural wonders. Surrounded by the bluest of sea, Capri has been enchanting visitors for centuries. From the ruins of Roman villas to splendid private residences, you can wander along little lanes amidst gardens overflowing with bougainvillea, plumbago and grapevines. Back in Sorrento, balance of the day is at leisure. Take the opportunity to explore its narrow streets and its local artisan shops. Tonight toast to new friendships and unforgettable moments at your Farewell dinner served at a local restaurant. Overnight in Sorrento. **Meals: Breakfast**









Day 9: Monday, April 20, 2026

Naples - Home Cities

Bidding a fond farewell to Italy, glide across the Bay of Naples one last time under the stern gaze of the Vesuvius volcano as we transfer by coach to the Naples airport for our flights home.
